When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed including the following:

1. **Read all instructions.**
2. To protect against electrical hazards, **DO NOT** immerse cord, plug or appliance in water or other liquid.
3. **Close supervision is necessary** when used by or near children.
4. **ALWAYS** unplug from outlet when not in use.

11. When using this product, make sure your pet has the option of sleeping on or OFF the bed.

Instructions

1. Carefully position heating pad between outer and inner lining and close the opening so your pet cannot remove the heating pad. When in use, check the pad to ensure proper positioning.
2. Turn the bed so the cord is exiting the back of the bed, away from the normal path traveled by your pet.
3. When cleaning the bedding, unplug and remove the heater so you do not subject it to being immersed in liquids or cleaners.
4. Follow the above instructions when reassembling your THERMO-SNUGGLY SLEEPER.
5. **ALWAYS** give your pet the choice to lie on OR off the heated bed.

Testing your new THERMO-SNUGGLY SLEEPER™

After operating 1-2 hours, place a pillow on your pet's new THERMO-SNUGGLY SLEEPER. After 15-20 minutes place your hand under the pillow to feel for warmth. The THERMO-SNUGGLY SLEEPER is designed to provide mild radiant warmth.

(Cool Bed III Insert)

Thank you for purchasing the All Season Snuggly Sleeper by K&H Manufacturing. Please read all instructions before using this product.

Step 1. Remove the Cool Bed III Snuggly Sleeper insert from the bed and remove the included insert cover. Locate the filler cap on the bed and open it by grasping the base of the cap with one hand and the tab of the cap with the other.

Step 2. With the cap side of the Cool Bed III insert facing up for filling, place a towel under the filler cap end of the bed to absorb any accidentally spilled water. Using a calibrated container with a pour spout, begin carefully filling the Cool Bed III insert with cool water. The bed will take the following water quantities. Keep in mind, the more water used, the more cushioning and cooling capabilities the bed will have. You can experiment for the optimal feel of the Cool Bed III Snuggly Sleeper. Ultimately the recommended quantity of water for best cooling capabilities is as follows:

Medium Cool Bed III Snuggly Sleeper Insert: 1.5 gallons

Large Cool Bed III Snuggly Sleeper Insert: 2 gallons

The water in the Cool Bed III Snuggly Sleeper insert should be around 15%-20% deeper than the Cool Core. What this means is that the Cool Bed III insert empty is around 1 inch thick. After filling and expelling the air, the bed should be a minimum of 1 3/16 inches thick. This extra water circulating through the Cool Core's channels will provide incredible cooling power.

Step 3. Now that you have your Cool Bed III Snuggly Sleeper insert filled, close the filler cap and begin to knead the bed to help work the water into the Cool Core. Now pull open the air adjustment valve and gently work as much air out as you can, using sweeping motions across the Cool Bed III insert with your hands. Sweep the air towards the valve allowing the air to expel from the bed. Seal the valve when most of the air has been removed. You will feel how comfortable the bed will be at this point. The bed should feel very soft and spongy and you should feel water squishing around inside the bed. Now decide if a little more water is desirable or if it's just right for your pet. Add water if necessary, repeating the air removal process. **Note:** A little air inside the bed will not affect the cooling capabilities of the Cool Bed III insert. If you choose, you may expel air as needed though not necessary.

Step 4. Your Cool Bed III Snuggly Sleeper insert is now ready to be turned over, inserted into the Snuggly Sleeper bed, and used by your pet. To turn the insert over, grasp the edges with both hands and roll the bed over. Be careful as the bed may be heavy. Place the included cover over the Cool Bed III Snuggly Sleeper insert before placing the insert into the bed. You may then grasp the edges of the bed to slide it into the Snuggly Sleeper for exact positioning.

How to empty your Cool Bed III Snuggly Sleeper Insert:

1) Open the filler cap. 2) Roll bed from opposite end, expelling water out of the cap. (much like rolling a sleeping bag) 3) Store with filler cap open.

How Does the Cool Bed III™ Snuggly Sleeper insert work?

Unlike a fluffy dog bed that is designed to retain heat to keep a dog warm, the Cool Bed III is designed to radiate heat back into the air or the floor surface to keep a dog cool. The water-saturated Cool Core™ inside the Cool Bed III absorbs the dog's natural body temperature of 102° Fahrenheit and converts it to room temperature, which is normally well below the dog's body temperature. The difference created between the room temperature and the dog's body temperature is how the Cool Bed III provides a cooler, refreshing surface for your dog. Even if it is 80°F in your house, the Cool Bed III is 22° cooler than a dog's 102° body temperature. The Cool Bed III provides a permanent, natural, "cool" spot for your dog, inside temperatures under 95° Fahrenheit without chemicals or electricity.

Precautions:

- ◆Have your dog's nails routinely trimmed to prevent accidental punctures.
- ◆Cool Bed should be placed on a smooth surface that cannot cause punctures, abrasions or leakage.
- ◆Routinely check under your Cool Bed III for moisture.
- ◆The surface can be cleaned using a damp towel or sponge and mild dishwashing detergent. Do not wash in a washing machine.
- ◆Never use the Cool Bed III in direct sunlight. Always place in shade, as direct sun will warm the Cool Bed III.
- ◆Always place the Cool Bed III out of the way of foot traffic.
- ◆Never allow the Cool Bed III to freeze.
- ◆Cool Bed III is not intended to be a life saving device.
- ◆This product is to be used in temperatures under 95° Fahrenheit

How to use your new Cool Bed III Snuggly Sleeper™

Be sure not to place the bed on sharp objects that could puncture the Cool Bed III. Be sure to place the Cool Bed III out of direct sunlight. The cooler the spot you place the Cool Bed III, the better. An ideal place would be a cool tile, linoleum or concrete floor. An area with good air movement will also help keep the bed cooler. You will soon figure out the best location for your new Cool Bed III, and your pet will love you for it!
